Schedule:

10.30 for 11.00 Meet at St John the Baptist church, Charlton (SP7 9LZ)

Parking by the Church restricted to disabled badge holders – all others please park in New Remembrance Hall car park (SP7 OPL) on the opposite side of A30 to the church. Then access through churchyard. Coffee will be available to start the day.

12.00 St Mary Church, Donhead St Mary (SP7 9DQ) Parking – details of parking will be forward to everyone who books in to the crawl.

1.00 pm Lunch at The Bennett Arms, Semley (SP7 9AS)

2.15 St Leonard’s Church, Semley.

3.15 The Most Holy Name and St Edward, King and Martyr. Salisbury Street, Shaftesbury (SP7 5EL)

It is always possible that these arrangements may have to change (funeral etc) so please check the web site or check with me before you set out. Car parking is the main difficulty when planning the crawls so please “double up” if you can and reduce the number of cars. Also please park thoughtfully; only parking right next to the church if you have a mobility problem.

There is a charge of £12.00 for the September Church Crawl which includes lunch. It is vital for the pub to know the number of people to cater for, so please let me know, as soon as you can, if you are planning to join us.
